

# Holy Trinity Parish Church, Lezayre



**Gt: 8,8,8,8,4,4,2, Sw: 8,8,8,8,4,1,8, Ped: 16,8.**

This instrument, by Ernest Wadsworth, replaces an earlier one by the same builder. It is possible that it uses parts of the first Wadsworth, in that there are obvious signs of internal alterations and additions. The Swell Oboe had insufficient space for its pipes and was removed to St. Matthew's Church, Douglas (also a Wadsworth.) It was replaced by a Sifflet 1 (the only one of its kind on the Island),

these changes being made by Peter Jones in 1985, when the instrument was last cleaned.

The key and stop actions are mechanical with pneumatic pedals.

The full organ sound, which owes much to the Cornopean stop on the Swell, is refined, well-rounded and dignified, filling the building. The quieter stops are likewise successful.
