
Marown Parish Church

This large, 2-manual organ was built by Alfred E Davies of Northampton and originally set up in the Douglas church of St Barnabas.

Sited in the north transept it is remarkable in its number of stops (the Great, for instance, has what amounts to 3 Diapasons) and complicated mechanical action to both manuals, pedals and stops.

This results in an instrument with a wide range of tone colours, but a heavy mechanism.

Nonetheless, the transept is shallow, and the organ speaks well into the building.
